Dear Parents/Caregivers,

As you know, Reflection Days and Retreats are an integral component of the school life of all students at Magdalene. The Reflection Day for Year 8, 2018, is part of the Year 8 Religious Education Program and will take place on Friday 30th November. It is our experience that all students really enjoy such days as they provide the opportunity, in a different context, to spend time with their friends, reflecting on important issues in their life.
